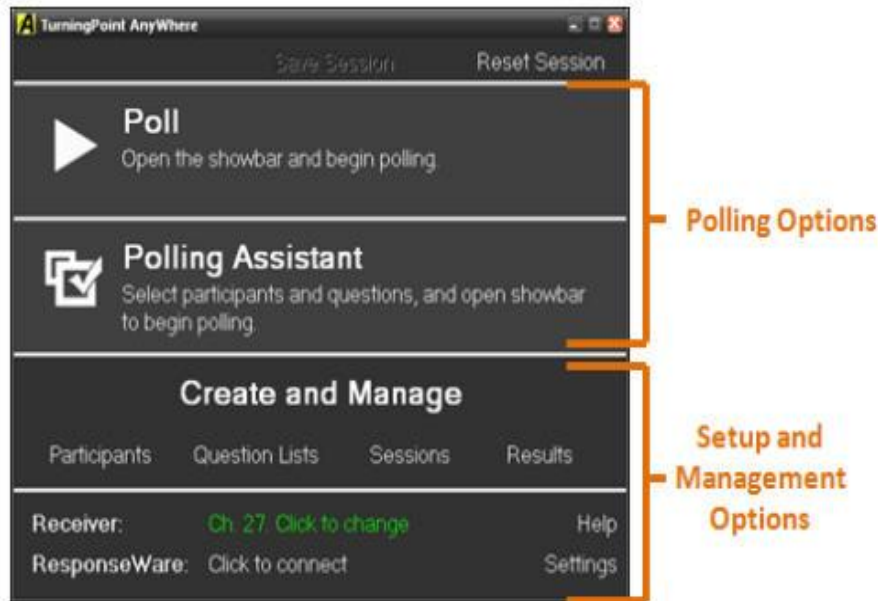


Clicker Instructions

1. Plug in the turning point receiver in the USB port.
2. Click on the Turningpoint Anywhere icon  on desktop to launch program.



3. Under Create and manage choose question lists, and then choose new question list. If you already have a question list saved you can choose question list and load.

Adding and removing questions

4. Enter your question in the first box and answers below. Add questions by choosing add question and choose question type. Add answers by choosing add answer choice. Mark correct and incorrect answers. The options under properties allow you to set a timer and show the correct answers during polling. The x next to each answer allows you to delete it.

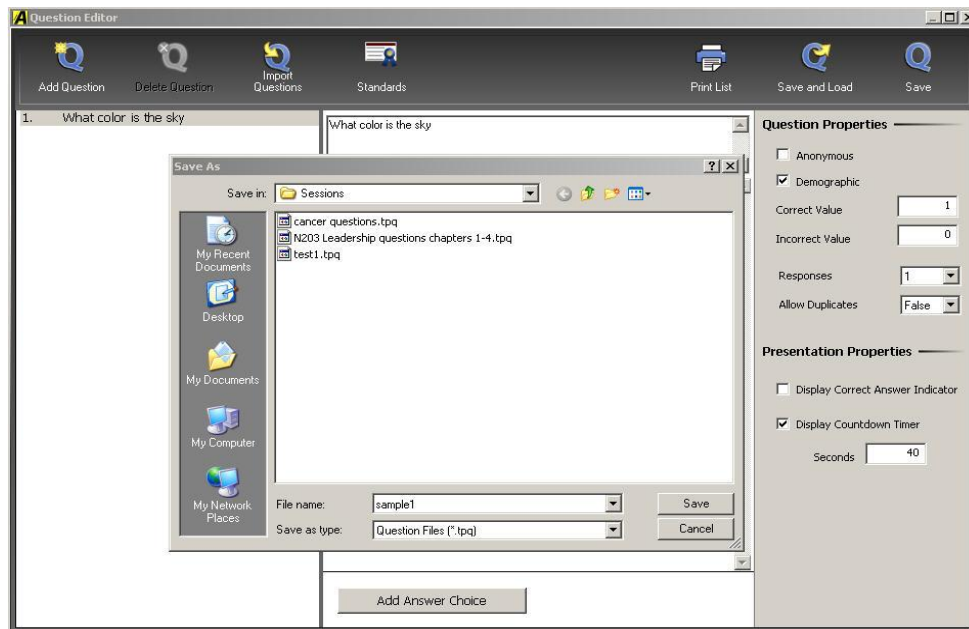

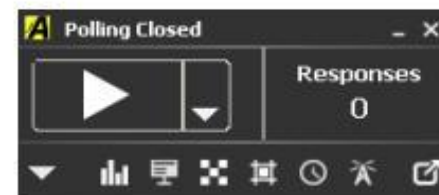
Buttons: Add Question, Delete Question, Import Questions, Standards, Print List, Save and Load, Save, Add Answer Choice.

Polling

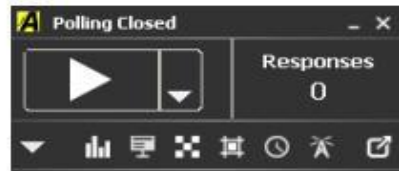
5. Choose save and load from the menu. Type in a name for your question list. (By default it saves to the session folder on that computer).



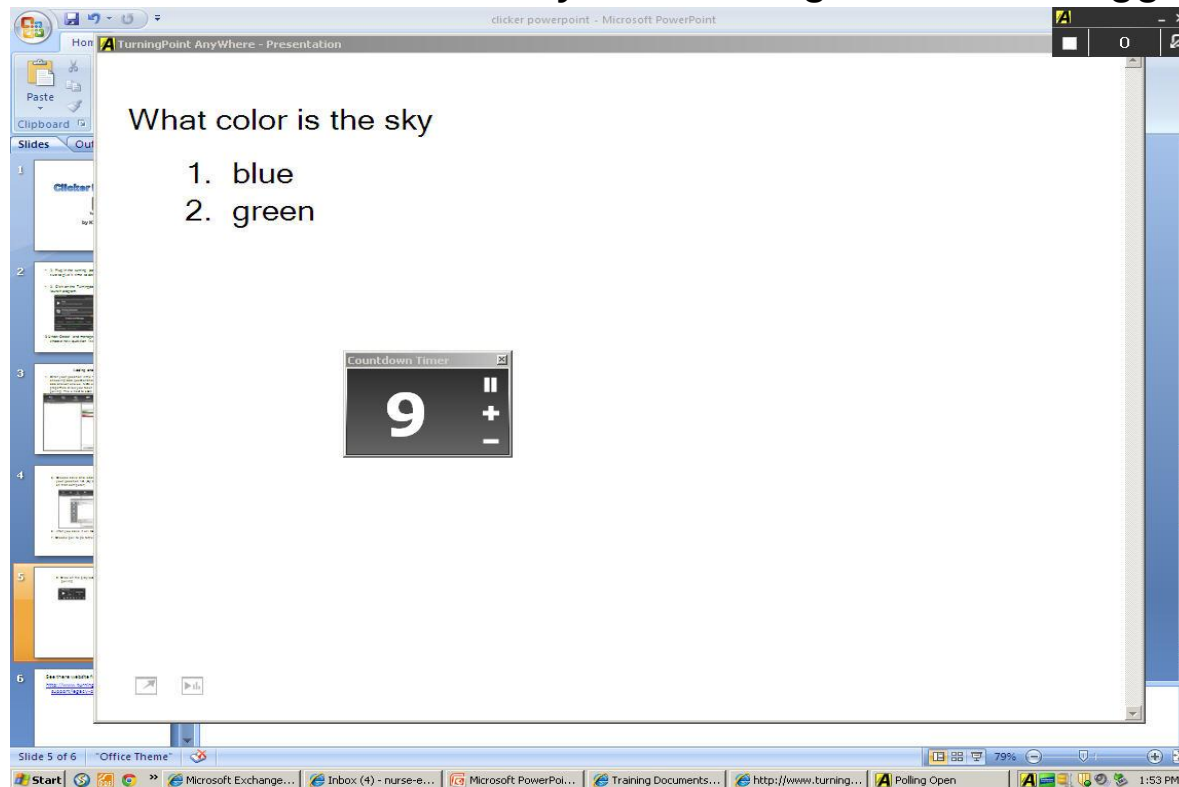
6. After you save it will take you back to the menu page
7. Choose poll to go to the polling bar



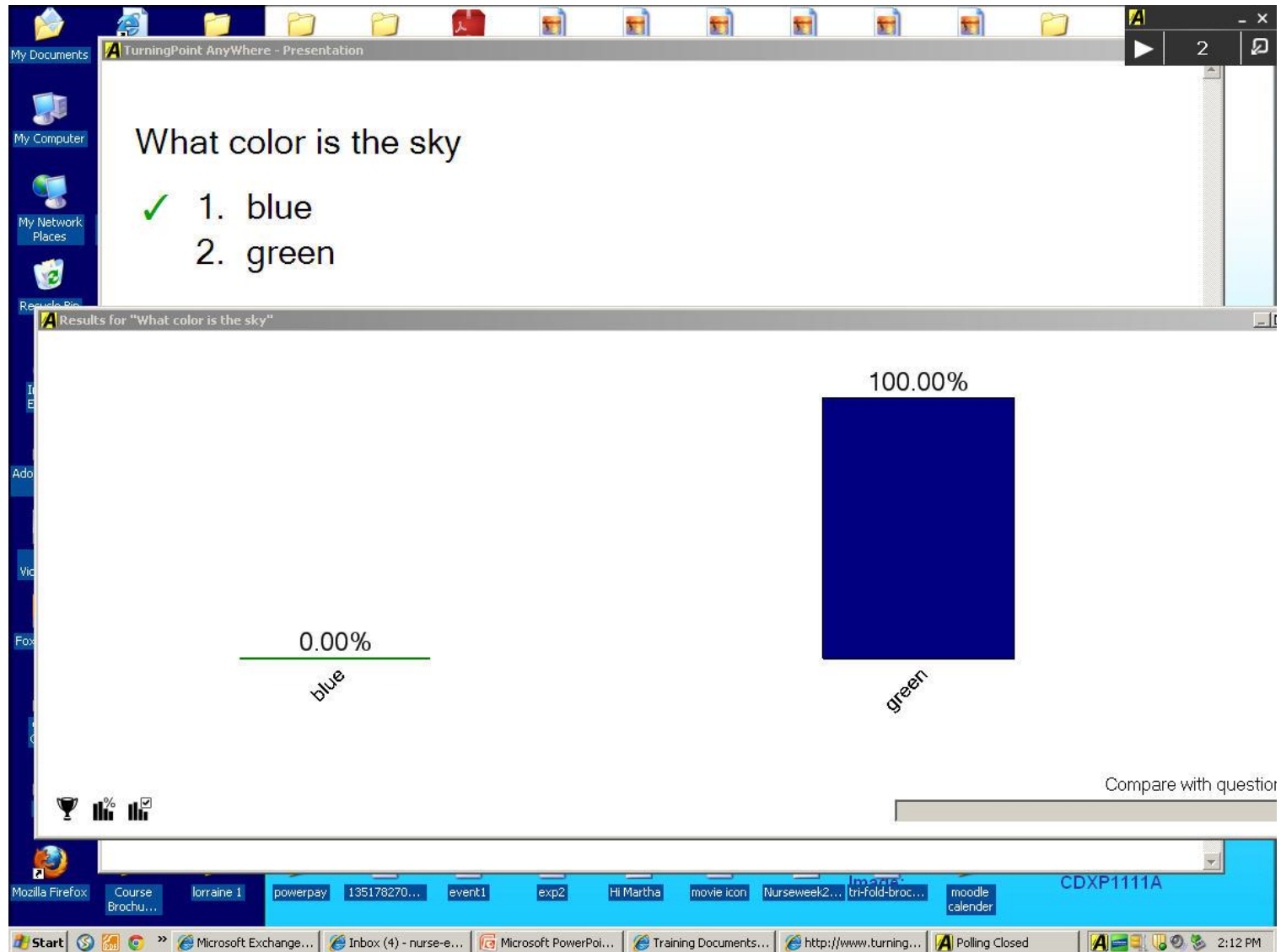
8. Click on the play icon on the to start polling



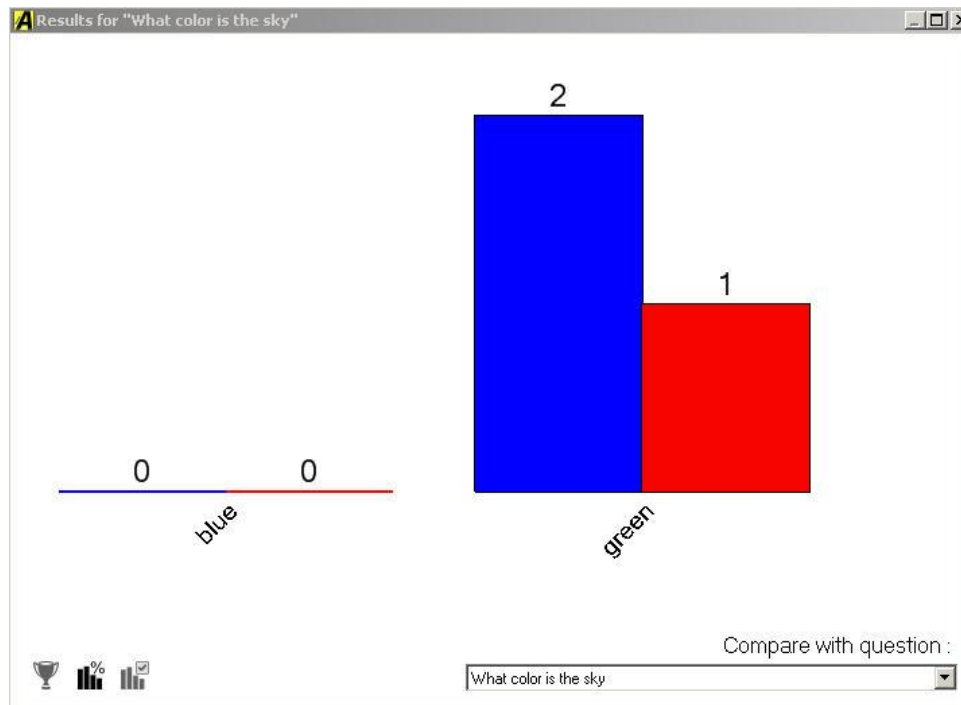
9. After clicking on play your question will be displayed and the timer will count down. The polling bar launches on the top right side of the screen. It can be moved by left clicking on it and dragging it.



10. After each question it will display a checkmark by the correct answer and the percentage.
